

# ATTENTION

## OWNERS / HANDLERS OF NON-UKC REGISTERED DOGS

Dogs not UKC registered the day of the hunt test may be entered in any of the following categories: Started, Seasoned, finished or Upland. The owner has 60 days to register the dog with UKC to keep the points earned at a Licensed Hunt Test.

Applications for Single Registration are available from the Hunt Test Secretary and are available from the UKC website [www.ukcdogs.com](http://www.ukcdogs.com). Please follow the General Information and Rules governing single Registration found on the back of the application.

Once the owner receives the dog's Registration papers, make a copy of the passed point receipt(s), insert the registration number on the copy of the point receipt(s), and mail it to UKC, Attn: Hunting Programs Department. If the dog has met the 60-day registration requirement, the points will be applied to the dog's record. After 60 days, the earned points will expire. However, the owner may reinstate the expired points by submitting a late fee of \$50 along with the copies of the expired point receipts.

Only dogs UKC registered when the hunt report has been received and processed by UKC will be included in the Honor roll or the Hunt Report sections of the *HUNTING RETRIEVER* Magazine.
